The programs that are selected will be grouped in tracks to allow participants to more easily outline their selections for attendance. Programs can apply to more than one track of learning.

Submitting a Proposal

If you would like to submit a program for consideration for the convention, use the online submission form. The online format is the only format that will be accepted for program submissions. A

worksheet has been provided for your convenience in planning. The worksheet and the online submission link are located in the Quick Links box above.

Be sure to read all of the instructions before beginning your submission. Once you begin the application process you will not be able to save and return to complete. The online form can also be accessed from the NYSPA website at www.nyspa.org.

Using the Worksheet

For your convenience in planning, these instructions have been provided in a pdf format. These are the same instructions that are on the online format. It is recommended that you review the instructions and prepare your answers before beginning the online process. By preparing answers in a word document (or any word processing program that will allow you to cut and paste) you can then cut and paste your answers to the online form while retaining a copy for yourself. When you are ready to enter your information you should plan at least 20 minutes to complete the process. It may be helpful to have your answers prepared in advance so you can copy and paste to the appropriate boxes in the form.

The deadline to receive proposals for presentations is **SEPTEMBER 20, 2010**. Programs received after this date will only be considered if there is a need for a second call for submissions. Programs submitted late are not guaranteed for review.
