He is a Clinical Professor of Psychiatry at the Medical University of South Carolina and Research Professor of Psychiatry at the State University of New York Upstate Medical University in Syracuse. A clinical scientist, educator, and practitioner, he has authored, co-authored, or co-edited 13 books and clinical manuals now numbering 23 separate editions, and published more than 230 scientific articles and book chapters related to the nature, assessment, and treatment of ADHD and related disorders. He has received multiple awards for his work, and has appeared as an expert on ADHD on 60 Minutes, the Today Show, Good Morning America, CBS Sunday Morning, CNN, and many other programs.
