SAGE (Secondary Analysis to Generate Evidence), an initiative from PolicyWise for Children & Families, is a data repository and research platform that enables the secondary use of data related to child and youth development, health, and well-being. SAGE increases the value of data by providing the infrastructure, processes, and governance to bring stakeholders together to use data in new ways and inform social policy and practice.

SAGE is requesting proposals for their Secondary Data Use Grant. The grant is an excellent opportunity for trainees and new researchers to work with existing and valuable birth cohort and survey data.
